

## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade School Supplies

### Pre-Algebra I

- TI-84 Plus Graphing Calculator – any version – Silver, Silver C, etc. (*Check Amazon for better pricing –used is fine!*)
- Graph paper
- Spiral notebook (for notes)
- 3-ring binder for handouts and returned papers (You may use this for more than one class if you wish.)
- 3 Dividers
- Pencils, highlighters
- Protractor and ruler

### Algebra I

- 5 section spiral notebook with pocket dividers for class notes and handouts
- 1 section spiral notebook for homework (100 pages or so works nicely)
- Pencils and erasers – Algebra is definitely a “pencil” activity
- Colored checking pens – used daily!
- TI-84 Plus Silver Edition Calculator (not needed at the beginning)

### English

- 1-2" 3-ring binder
- College-ruled notebook paper
- Dividers for binder (at least 3)
- Pencils
- Highlighter
- Colored pencils or markers or pens (for checking work/projects)
- Flash drive (to be kept in bookbag)

### History

- 3-ring binder w/ pockets (1 inch)
- marble composition notebook for journal
- colored markers for projects

### Phenomenon of Language (Latin)

- 3-ring binder\* 1” is fine for this class alone or see note about shared binders\*
- 3 dividers (labeled: Mythology, Language Study, Graded Assignments)
- Notebook paper
- Pencils/Highlighters/Colored Pencils
- Students work in a Latin workbook all year that is hole-punched and fits in a 1” binder for protection if needed

## Science

- 1-1" 3-ring binder
- college ruled notebook paper
- calculator
- pencils
- red ink pen
- black or blue ink pens
- highlighters
- colored pencils

## Writing

- 1 1" binder
- 1 2" binder
- 4 dividers for each binder
- Ink pens – red and black
- Colored pencils
- Notebook paper and pencils
- A Thesaurus

**\*Nota Bene-SHARED BINDERS:** Many 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade students find it helpful to have one LARGE 3 ring binder for morning classes (1<sup>st</sup> +2<sup>nd</sup> period are the classes before break), one for midday classes (3<sup>rd</sup>+4<sup>th</sup> period are the classes between break and lunch) and 1 smaller binder for 5<sup>th</sup> period (after lunch) (6<sup>th</sup> period is elective). Students may switch books/binders at their lockers at break and lunch so they don't have to carry all books/binders all day!
