***Nota Bene-SHARED BINDERS:** Many 7th/8th grade students find it helpful to have one LARGE 3 ring binder for morning classes (1st +2nd period are the classes before break), one for midday classes (3rd+4th period are the classes between break and lunch) and 1 smaller binder for 5th period (after lunch) (6th period is elective). Students may switch books/binders at their lockers at break and lunch so they don't have to carry all books/binders all day!
